



# Training Class Policies

If you've already registered or are considering registering for training class but aren't sure what else is expected or required. Don't worry because we've made it easy and laid it all out for you here. We want to thank you again for considering us for the honorable job of teaching you how to train your dog. We look forward to seeing you achieve all your training goals. Just don't forget to have fun along the way!

## Vaccine Requirements

- Bordetella every 6 months
- 1 or 3 year Rabies (*titers not accepted*)
- 1 or 3 year Distemper (*titers accepted*)
- Canine Influenza H3-N8 and H3-N2



Our reception team is happy to call your veterinarian office to confirm your pets' vaccines.

## Class Room Etiquette

- Please arrive 10 minutes prior to class start time in order to potty your dog(s) and allow them a few minutes to acclimate to the environment.
- Close toed shoes are required.
- Children attending should remain seated unless actively training with an adult supervising.
- For safety reasons we ask that your child not be allowed to play with or climb on the training equipment.
- Do not allow your dog to greet nose to nose or nose to rear at any time during class unless told otherwise.
- If a dog is loose, please refrain from giving it affection (hands on or talking) while the owner recalls it.
- Please pick up after your dog. Cleaning supplies and bags are readily available for your use.

## What to bring to class

Please review your specific class description handout. This will give you a full list of specifics, if any, that are needed for each class. When in doubt always bring the following with you to every class.

- A positive attitude!
- Standard collar (*Belt, buckle or martingale*)
- Training aid if needed (*Harness, head halter etc.*)
- 6 foot leash
- Non-squeaky toy (*Tug toy*)
- Portable water bowl
- Treat carrying pouch, apron or pockets.
- Minimum of 2 types of soft pea sized treats (*avoid dry, crumbly and large treats*)

**Treat ideas:** Baked chicken or turkey, turkey jerky, lunch meat, Ziwi Peak, string cheese, hot dog, steak or liver. For dogs who are overweight and aren't picky please feel free to use their kibble as one of your two treat choices.

## Not permitted in class

- A negative attitude!
- Flexi lead (*aka retractable leash*)
- Choke chain
- Shock collar
- Citronella collar
